### Greetings

#### Oi / Ola

*Hi / Hello*

Oi is casual and everywhere. Ola is slightly more formal.

#### Tudo bem?

*How are you?*

Most common greeting. Reply: 'Tudo bem!' or just 'Tudo!'

#### Bom dia / Boa tarde / Boa noite

*Good morning/afternoon/evening*

Used entering shops, elevators, passing neighbours. Always appreciated.

4

#### Prazer!

*Nice to meet you!*

Said when meeting someone new. Usually followed by a kiss on the cheek.

### Restaurant

5

#### Um cafezinho, por favor

*A coffee, please*

Say 'cafezinho' — sounds friendly and local, not touristy.
